In view of the latest development of COVID-19, with effect from 6 January 2020, Tsz Shan Monastery will only maintain partial opening and tighten its preventive measures, as follows:

1. Changes in daily activities

a. All visitors must scan the LeaveHomeSafe (LHS) venue QR code using the LHS mobile application before entering the premises. Having considered that some individuals are unable to meet the requirement of using of the LHS mobile application due to reasonable reasons, the following three categories of persons may fill in a specified form as an alternative to the use of the LHS mobile application:
(i) persons aged 65 or above and aged 15 or below;

(i) persons aged 65 or above and aged 15 or b

(ii) persons with disability; and

(iii) other persons recognised by the Government or organisation(s) authorised by the Government.

b. All indoor areas in the monastery are temporarily closed, such as the Buddhist Art Museum, the Lecture Hall and other Temple Halls.

c. Suspension of the following daily activities: Water offering, Zen calligraphy and guided tours.

d. Suspension of group visits: All group visits of 15 or more participants will be cancelled.

2. Changes in ritual ceremonies/ Buddhist programmes:

a. 9/1/2022 The Celestial Offering will be changed to an online live broadcast event.

b. 16/1/2022 - 22/1/2022 The 7-Day Meditation Camp will be cancelled.

The Monastery will closely monitor the development of the pandemic and review the above arrangements on 12 January 2022.
