Starting from 21 April 2022 (Thursday), Tsz Shan Monastery will be re-opened to the public. Please note that:

- Online registration system will be opened on 19 April 2022 9:00am. You may register in advance for a visit.
- For arrangements for the collection of Lotus Lights, we shall make announcements via email on or before 20 April 2022.

Taking the health of our visitors into consideration, the following special precautionary measures will be implemented:

- All persons must comply with the relevant requirements under the “Vaccine Pass” and will be required to use the “LeaveHomeSafe” mobile application.
- Visitors are required to check their body temperature before entering the monastery. For those with fever symptoms will not be admitted.
- Visitors must wear a mask at all times during their visit.
- To avoid people from gathering, visitor flow control measures will be implemented in designated areas. Please follow instructions of our staff.
